



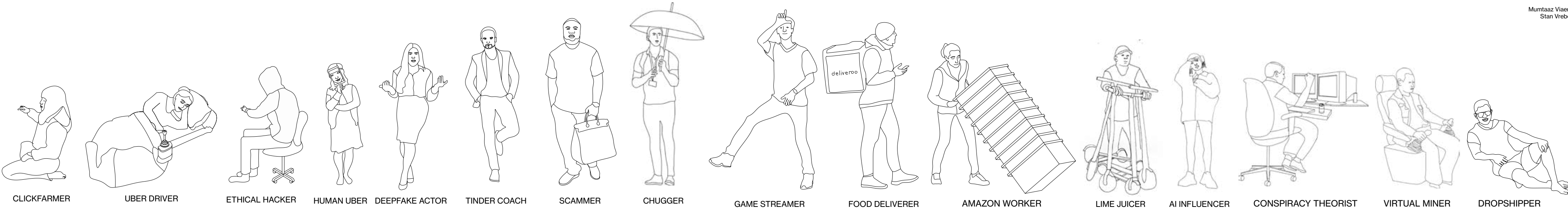

WORKERS OF THE TECHNOSPHERE

The technosphere is related to the Anthropocene, the geological era when humans have emerged as the dominant forces shaping the planet. The cybernetic aspect of the technosphere relates to the increasing autonomy and rise of technology. Automation causes manual, precarious labour to shift to online platforms. New jobs supporting and desgining emerging technologies that shape the labour of modern society are constantly popping up. Some are easily noticed in public, others aren't.

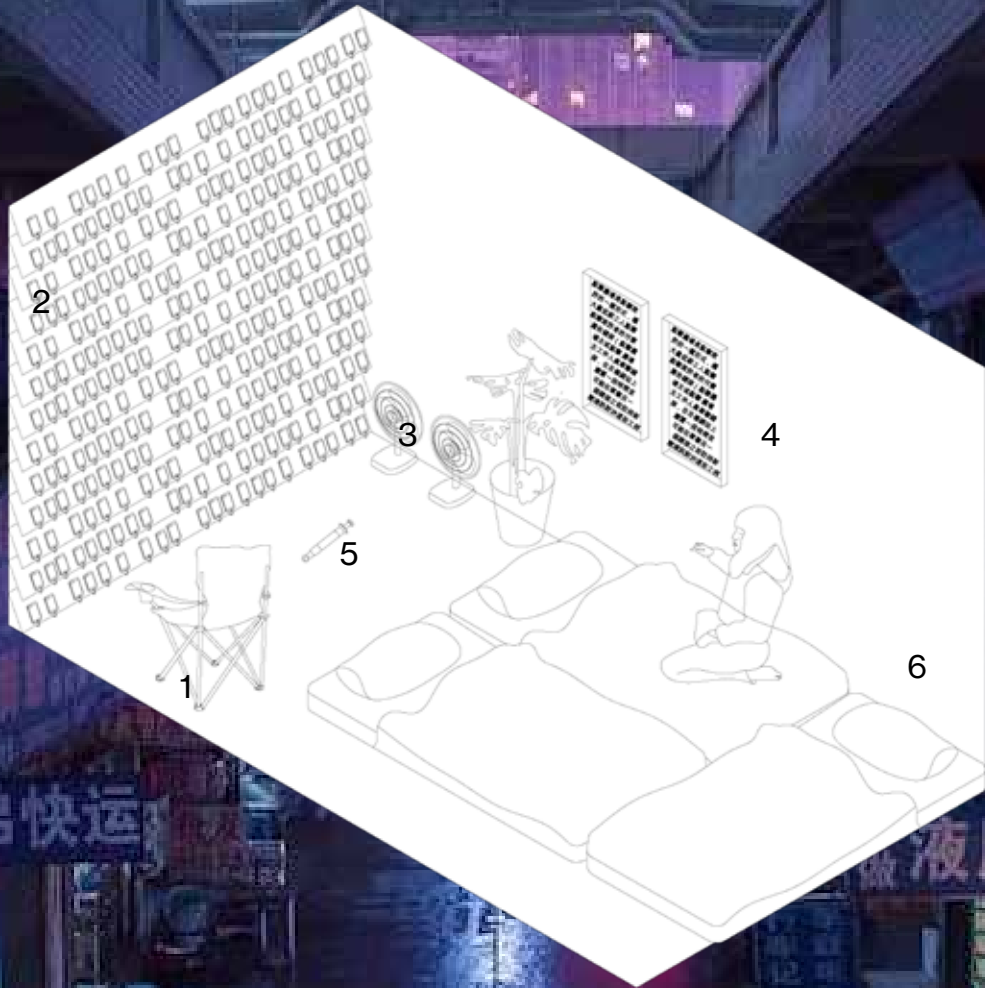
The technosphere has a drastic impact on the way people work. The gig economy has invaded many job environments largely based on temporary labor or freelance work. This flexibility brings many job opportunities. Working through digital platforms create freedom to roam the world while practicing our jobs. Are our ways of living and working shifting, from a sedentary to a nomadic lifestyle? The workers of the technosphere can move from city to city. It's not neccesary for them to have a fixed living base, they can work remotely from any location. We chose 15 modern workers that grabbed our attention. By making a catalogue of personas and their living space supported by found references, we try to shine a light on their work and lifestyle. We zoom out further locating their interiors in a bigger scale and looking for the duality of the luxurious and precarious nature surrounding these technosphere workers.

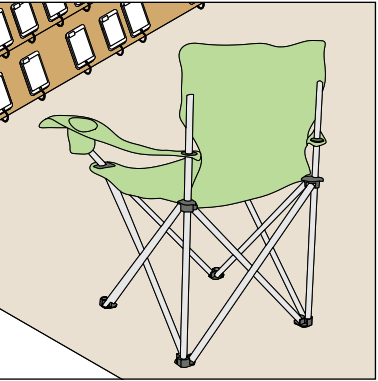


Chinese district at night

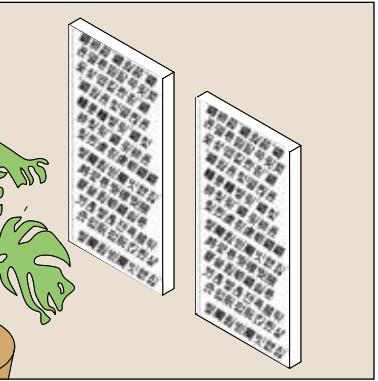


CLICKFARMER

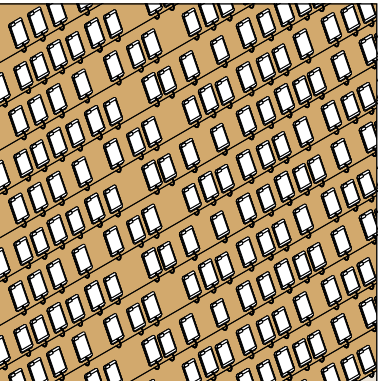
In a click farm, online bought followers, likes, comments and views are created. The farmers get paid according to their clickingspeeds.



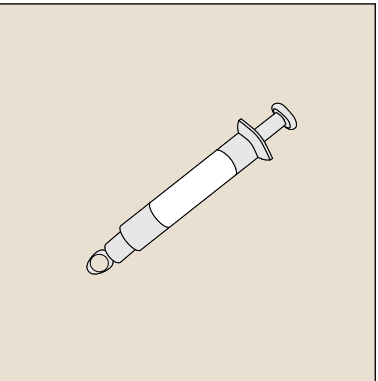
1. A clickfarmer has to stay in the same position all day, so a comfortable chair with an easy access drinkholder cup is a necessary luxury in order to perform the job.



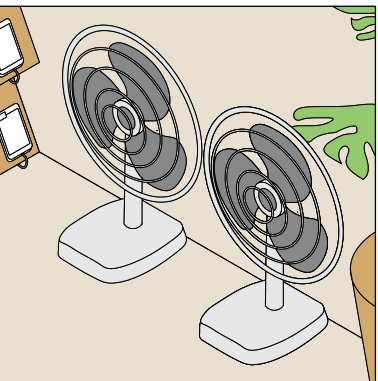
4. The click farms are not regulated, as they are illegal operations. This created little social, mental and physical security for the people working in clickfarms.



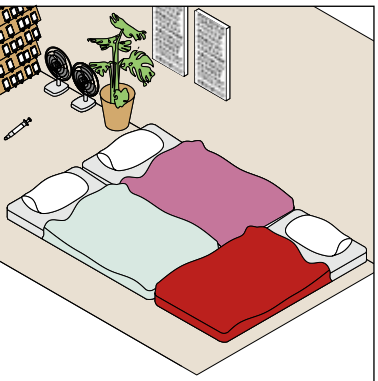
2. Often one clickfarmer operates large racks with many phones mounted on it, constantly searching for error pop-ups.

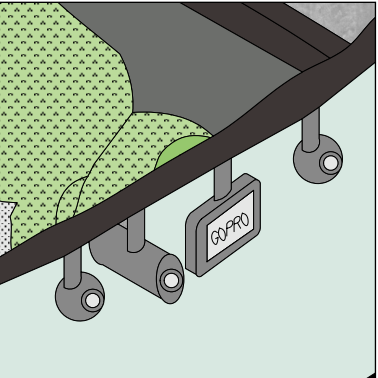

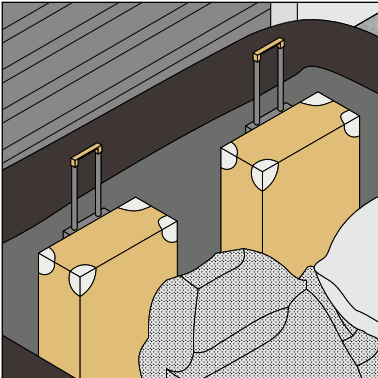

UBER DRIVER

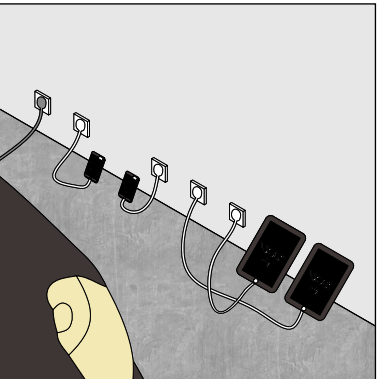
Uber allows people who own a vehicle to sign up and become a driver, passengers who want to have a ride can call for a car using the Uber app in their smartphone.



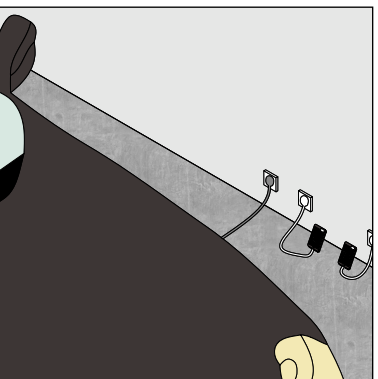
1. With roadrage and increased pressure from insurance companies, dashcams are becoming more common in cars.



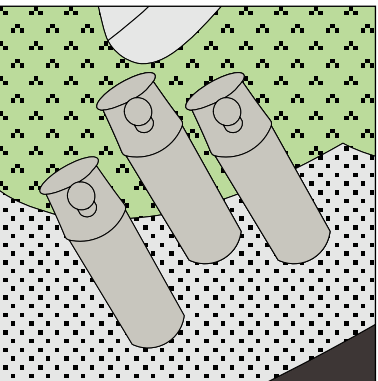
4. With low wages, large costs and little security, some Uber drivers in densely populated areas are left to live inside their own cars.

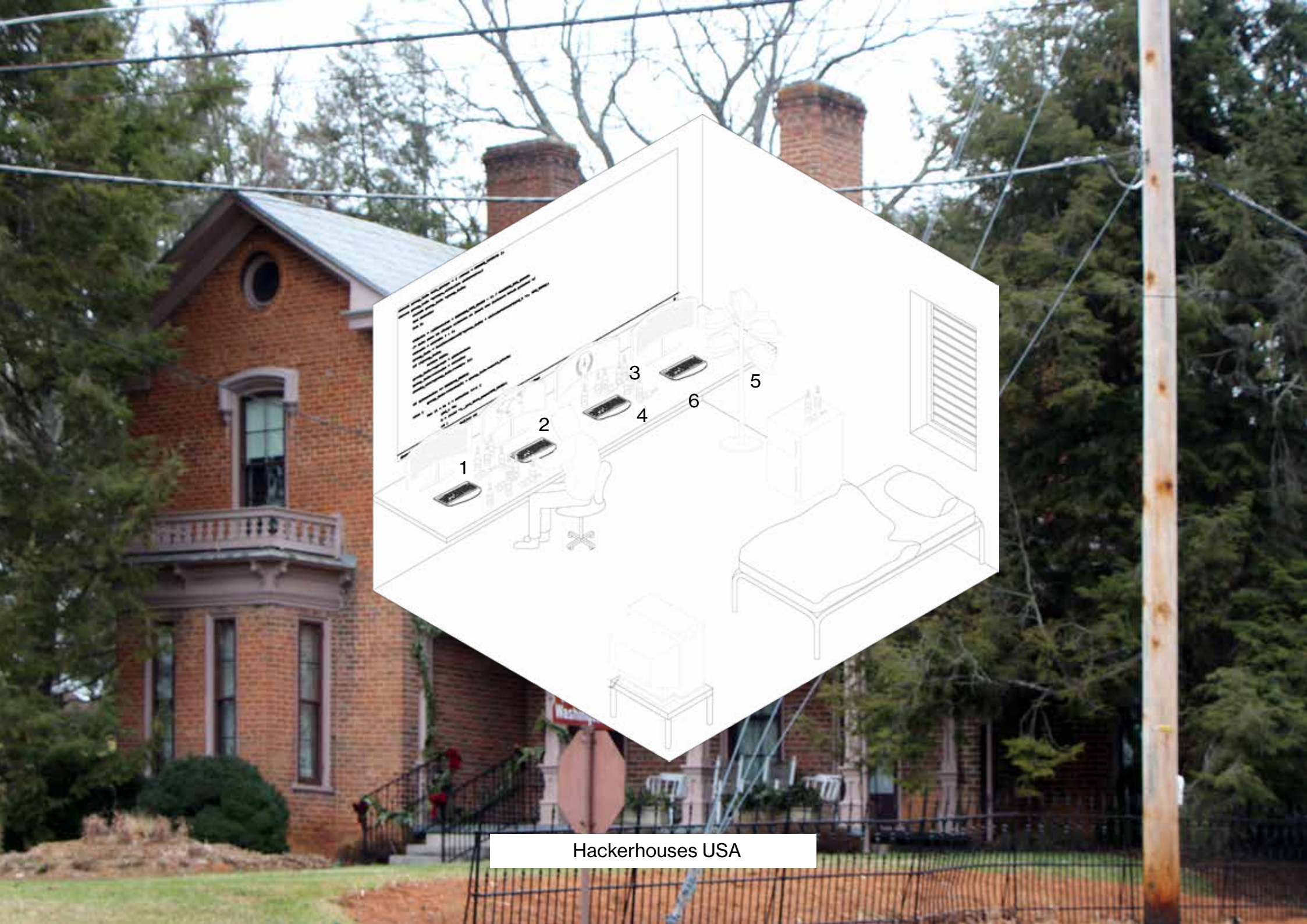

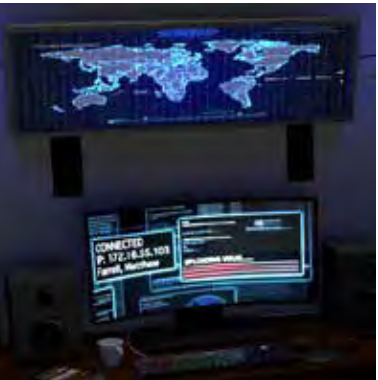
ETHICAL HACKER An ethical hacker, or white hat hacker, is an information security expert who attempts to penetrate digital systems to find security vulnerabilities.

4. Club Mate has developed a following in computer hacker culture and tech start-ups, especially in Europe. With hacketons (marathons for hackers) where allnighters are very common.



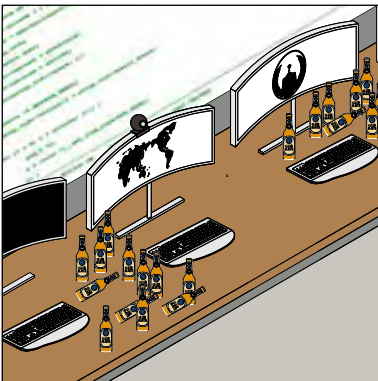
2. The internet is globally connected. You never know where the person you are talking to actually comes from.

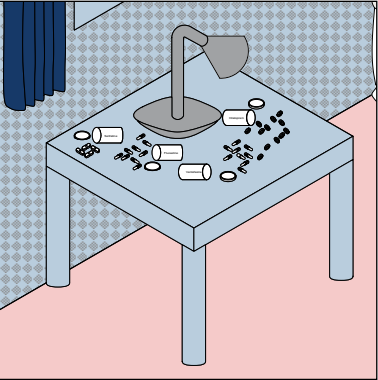

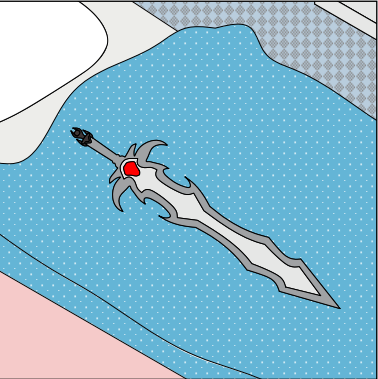
Japanese researcher Jun Rekimoto has developed a special screen that can be strapped to a person's face and allow them to go out into the world on your behalf.

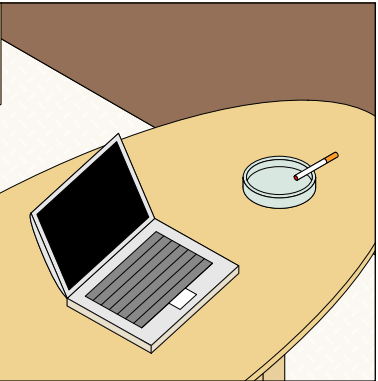
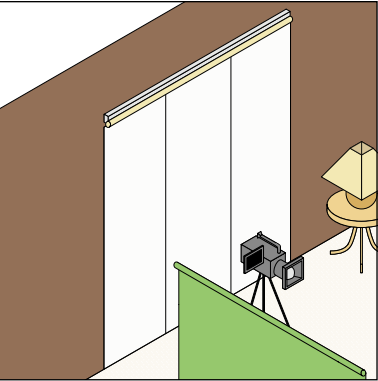

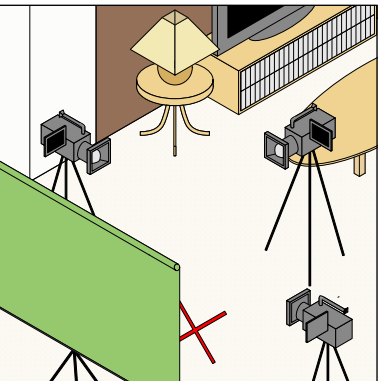
The term deepfake is typically used to refer to a video that has been edited using an algorithm to replace the actor's face in the original video with someone else (especially a public figure).



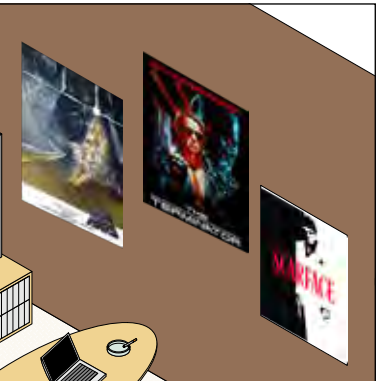
1. Mirror practice, a common exercise mimicing facial expressions.

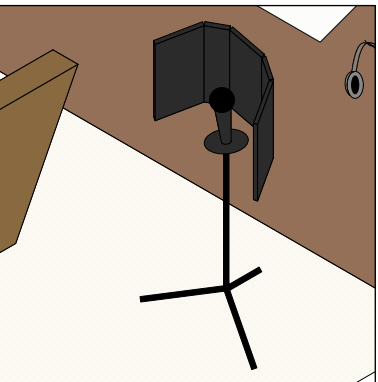
2. Face mapping, a complete image is generated combining shots from three angles.

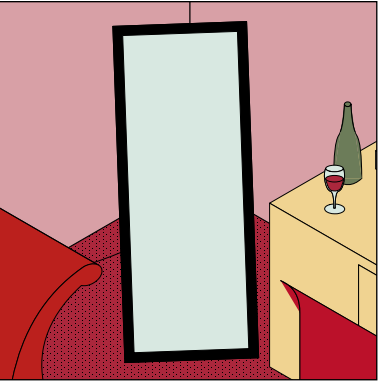

TINDER COACH

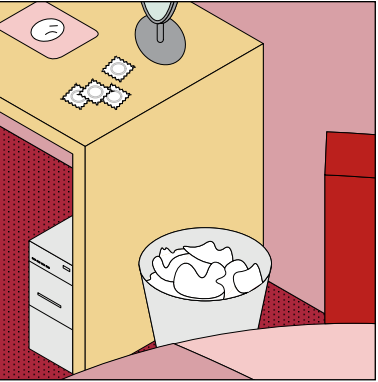
A tinder coach is someone who offers their matchmaking skills online. They give advise on how to build your profile and how to message with your matches.



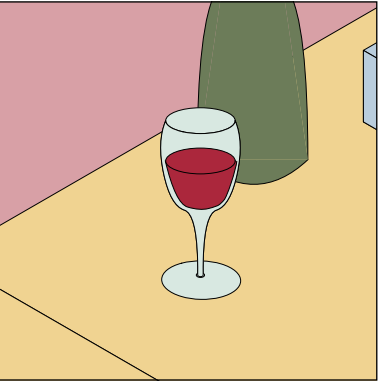
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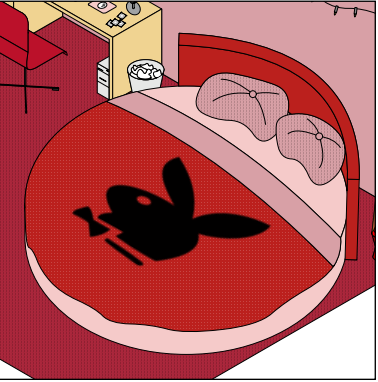

STREET FUNDRAISER ‘chugger’

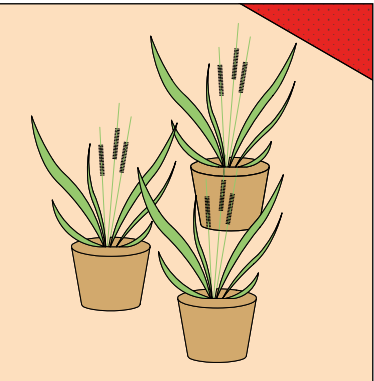
A chugger is a person who approaches passers-by in the street asking for subscriptions or donations to a particular charity.



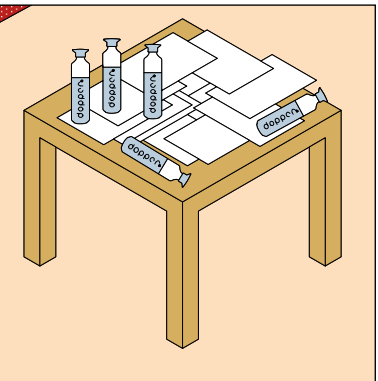

GAME STREAMER

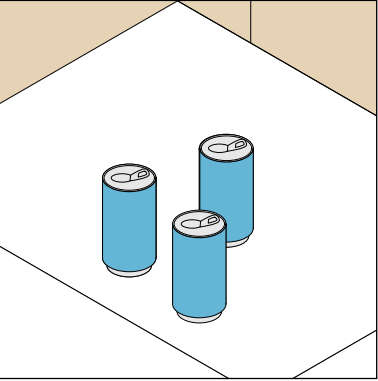

FOOD DELIVERER

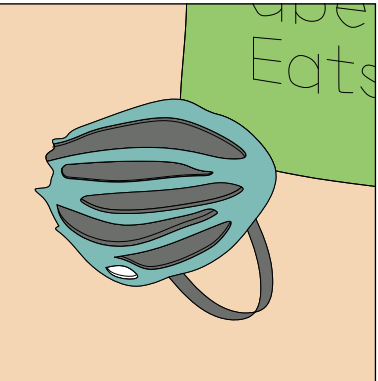
Retail food delivery is a courier service in which a restaurant, store, or independent food-delivery company delivers food to a customer.

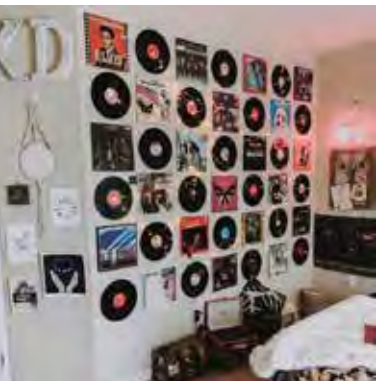
4. Bike on the wall, drivers often have very expensive bikes that they buy themselves, wich leaves them with little revenue.



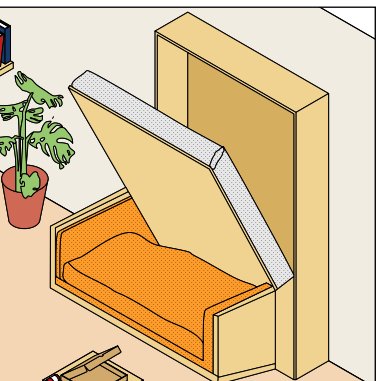

AI INFLUENCER

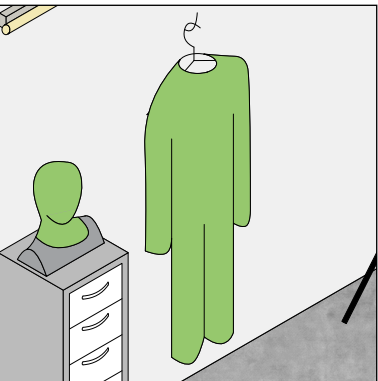
With the incline of digital modification software, faces online become more distant from reality. In the last few years AI or artificial intelligence influencers have gained attraction online. These personas are completely created virtually.



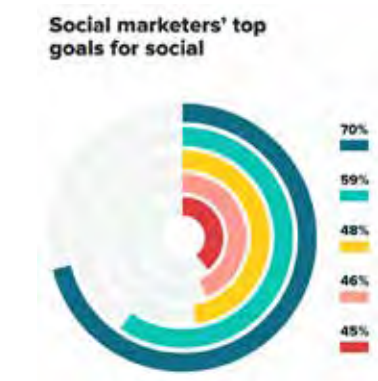

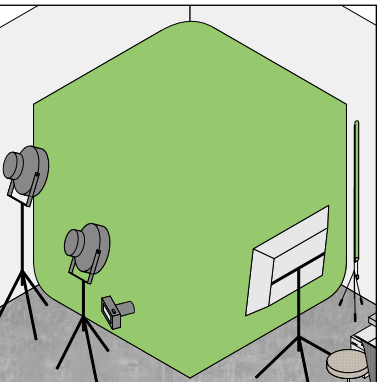
4. Creating of a CGI model. Shudu, a black AI model created by a company led by white workers.



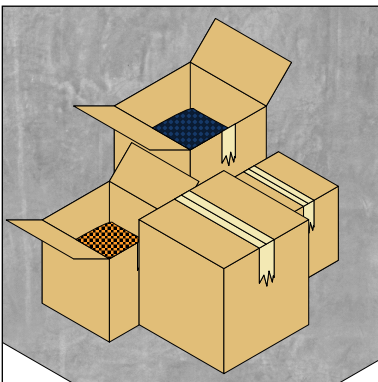

CONSPIRACY THEORIST

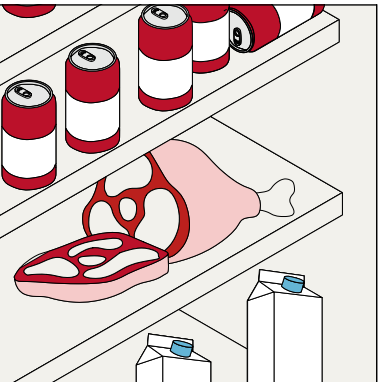

1. The bear hunt has a very bad impact on ecosystems. It only creates status symbols.



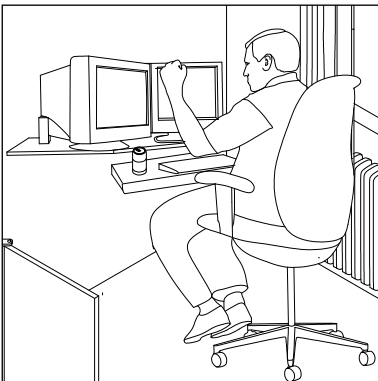

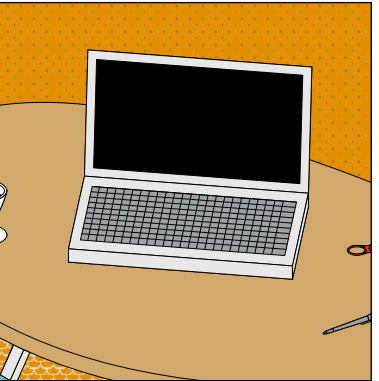
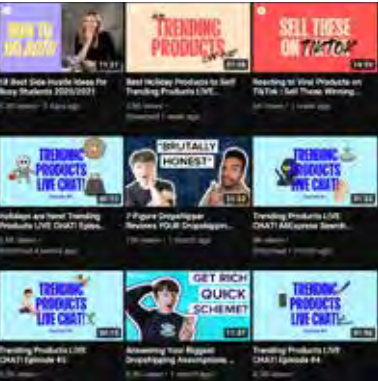
1. Ethical risks are involved, as products are often produced in low quality working environments.

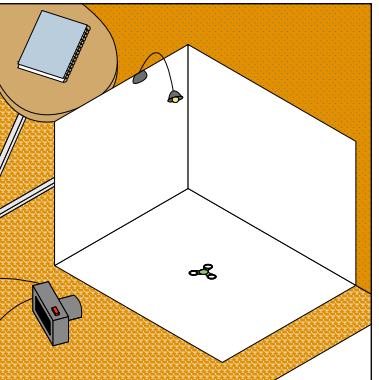
2. With the enormous category on dropshipping books, it makes it easy for anyone to start. Most of the titles are the same and the content will not differ that much.

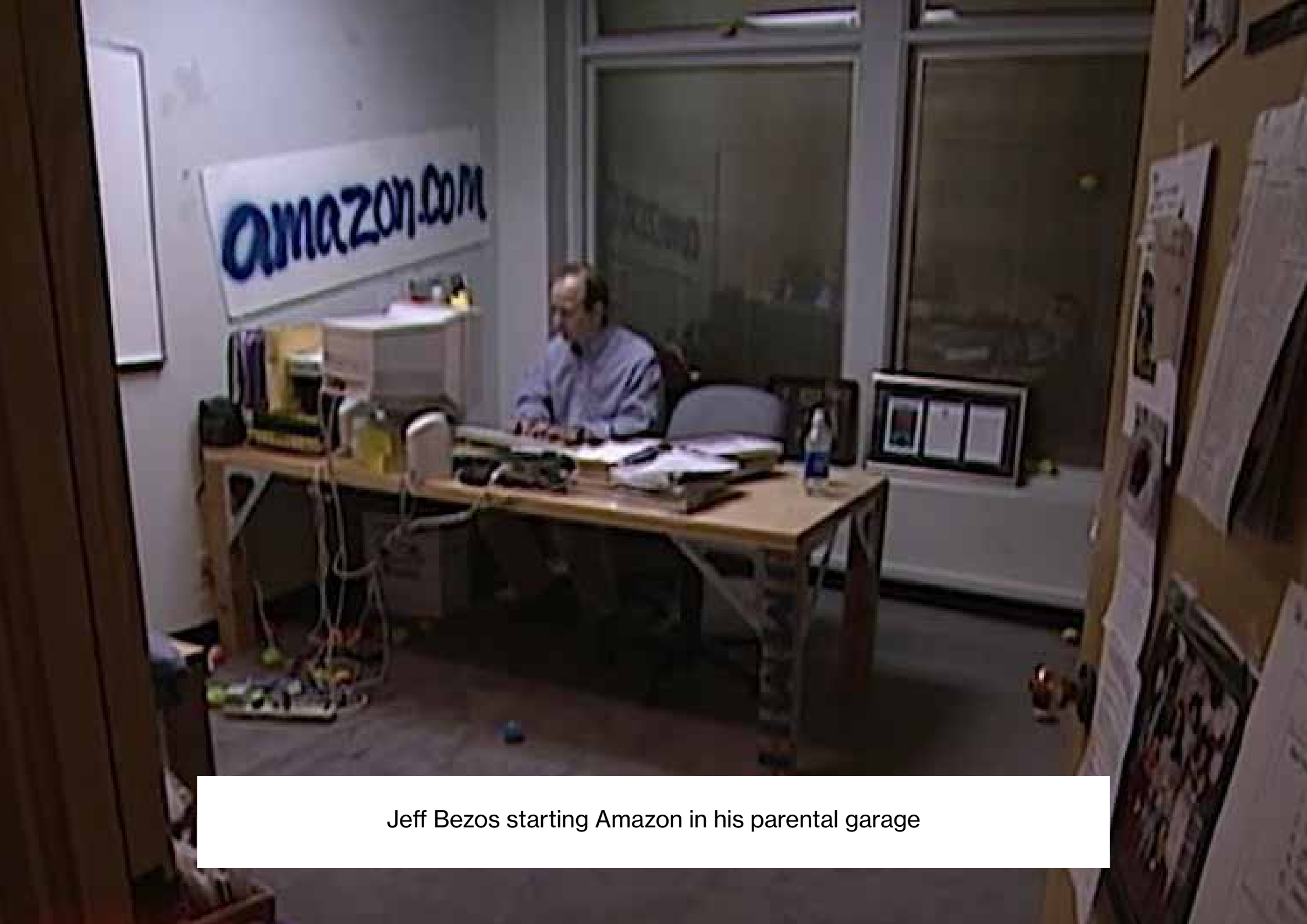

CONCLUSION

The jobs created through the technosphere rely on digital platforms, automation and online connections. They are often disconnected from society and practiced in secluded, dark environments. Plenty of these jobs are focused on image creation and increasing revenue. This duality questions the reality of the workforce. They might have a glamorous appeal through the image of the multinational tech-companies and the individualistic methods. In reality only few can take advantage of the luxurious lifestyles, while others are left in a precarious position. They live in overpopulated, polluted, insecure environments and don't have access to good healthcare and job security. This is the price they pay for the flexibility of their contracts. It disconnects them from society and the benefits of a open-ended contract. They can be artists through the day and be delivering pizza's at night. In reality many of these jobs are executed by unschooled people that use it as their only revenue, without providing enough means to have decent living conditions.

These jobs are focused on online presence, but disregard their realities. Dropshippers, tinder coaches, AI-influencers and lime juicers convince people online to take part in these "easy money jobs" through youtube videos and instagram posts. The reality is concealed, a anthropogenic neo-liberal scam, with similarities to a pyramid scheme. These flexjobs increase the wage gap. Rich people get richer, while others meddle their way through precarious working conditions, because of the lack of a better alternative. They pay the price of the new found luxuries of society. One day these workers of the technosphere will become automatized as well and new luxurious and precarious jobs will arise.
